The 129th Birth Anniversary of Dr. S. R. Ranganathan is being celebrated as Librarians' Day on 12th August 2021 throughout the country. On this special day we - the library and information science professionals pay homage to the father of Library Science in India.

I think you all are aware that this is the first time in the history of ALA an Elected Body took charge of the association. ALA was established in 1938 with the active involvement of Late Kumudeswar Barthakur with a view to creating a library movement in the state of Assam by establishing village-based district wise Public Library System. By doing so the state of Assam became the 8th state in the country to establish a state-level library association. The association was supported wholeheartedly by the stalwart like Lokopriya Gopinath Bordoloi, Bishnu Duarah, Raghunath Choudhury, Benudhar Sharma, Harendra Nath Barua, Professor emeritus Pandit Maheswar Neog, Pandit Tirthanath Sharma, Giridhar Sarma, Ayodhya Prasad Goswami and many more.

Dr Ranganathan personally visited Assam during the 8th conference of Assam Library Association at Guwahati which was organised under the chairmanship of Prof. Emeritus Pandit Maheswar Neog during 24-25 October 1964. Along with him Prof. P. N. Kaula, Dr. A. Ohdedar, etc added an additional flavour to the conference thus creating history for Assam Library Association. During this conference, it was decided to open a Library Science course at Gauhati University for training the librarians of not only the state of Assam but the entire North-Eastern region of India and thus the Department of Library Science started functioning by providing an evening course in 1966 under the headship of Dr. Jogeswar Sarma, then Librarian of Gauhati University Central Library.

Dr. Ranganathan also tried for the enactment of public library legislation by preparing a draft bill, which was placed in the 8th conference in 1964, but is very unfortunate for all of us that it could not be materialized to date. Now the existing body of ALA has taken up this matter as its first priority and a draft committee has been constituted to initiate the process. We are hopeful that something good will come out from the endeavour from this new energetic committee. This committee has successfully completed the induction programme for library professionals where the participants from all over India took an active part.

Till date the association has published several publications like News Bulletins, Seminar Volumes, Granthalok, Let us Read Books (in Assamese & English language) and such others. The association has also organised a one week training programme for non-professionals working in different libraries under the banner of RRRLF, Kolkata starting from 12th August, 2014. It also observed Public Library Day on 22nd May 2015. Under the sponsorship of RRRLF, the association organised a seminar on Public Librarianship and Glorious Heritage of Karmabir Nabin Chandra Bordoloi Library (Reading Hall): Plan for Renovation and Development during 22-23 January 2017.

To mark the occasion of Librarians' Day 2021, ALA has organised an invited talk on Public Library as a Powerful Institute for Realising Democracy. Narendra Lahkar, Retired Professor and Head of Dept. of Library and Information Science, GU; Dr Mukesh Saikia, Librarian, Tezpur University; Sjt Dwijendra Narayan Sarma, Founder & Chief Executive of Prerona Puthibharal, Nalbari; and Dr Mehtab Hussain, District Librarian, Guwahati, Kamrup Metro are invited to share their views and experiences on the topic.

The association has been trying to create library awareness and promote reading habits among the society and academic fraternity since its inception. We are very much optimistic that we will be able to take this association in the midst of society.

A REPORT ON ALA (2018-20)

General Secretary

September 1, 2018 – November 20, 2020

The 2018-2020 executive committee was formed on 12th August, 2018. The committee took charge of the association on 1st September, 2018 and served till 20th November, 2020. A few months later, Dr. Kishor Sarma, Treasurer of the ALA resigned from his duties. Thereafter, as per the resolution of the executive committee held on 14th September, 2019 Dr. Mukesh Saikia, Working President and Prof. Sanjay Kumar Singh, Vice-President of the ALA were entrusted with the additional charge of President and Treasurer respectively instead of selecting / electing a new President and Treasurer of the association. The various initiatives taken during the the tenure i.e., 2018-2020 are furnished below,

i) Executive Committee Meetings:

The 1st meeting of the new executive committee (EC) of 2018 was held on 1st September, 2018 in the Department of Library & Information Science, Gauhati University and the subsequent EC meetings were held on 14th September, 2019, 29th February, 2020 and 20th November, 2020. All the notifications along with minutes were uploaded on the ALA website.

ii) General Body Meeting: A general body meeting of the ALA was held on 9th February, 2019 at the Phanidhar Datta Seminar Hall, Gauhati University, Guwahati.

iii) Divisional Member of ALA:

The Executive Committee meeting held on 29th February, 2020, considered Women Librarians' Association of Assam (WLAA)

established in the year 2020 with Dr. Jyotika Devi as President and Dr. Kankana Baishya as General Secretary as the 1st divisional member of Assam Library Association with membership No. ALAD001

iv) Life Membership of ALA: ALA had 76 life members enrolled in the previous years. Therefore, wide campaign was carried out to increase the life members of the association and accordingly 98 new life members were registered during the period bearing membership Id No. up to ALAL176. All the divisional members, institutional members and life members were issued the membership certificate and the membership fees were directly credited to the ALA account.

v) Institutional Member of ALA:

Students union body of the colleges, librarian and principal of the colleges were intimated through emails for ALA institutional / association membership. Consequently 7 new institutional members have been registered during the period with Membership No. ALAI001 to ALAI007.

vi) Increase in ALA Capital: The new executive body took charge of the association with Rs. 11,939.93 in the bank account of the association without any other financial assets. During the tenure of the past EC, the bank-balance of the ALA has been increased from Rs. 11,939.00 to Rs. 1,01,501.00. All the amounts collected as life membership fees were deposited in a separate fixed deposit account of the ALA.

vii) Up-gradation of the Website: The ALA website was upgraded by incorporating new information and new facilities like opening up the provision of the online membership by using Google Form and submission of the membership fees online, displaying list and address of all the members in pdf files, hosting Email of all key officials of the ALA in Google Workspace, displaying list of publications, hosting and scanning of audited accounts of ALA, publications of ALA; making ALA logo more legible and such others.

viii) Examination Question Papers: In the tenure of the past EC, Examination Question Papers (<http://eqp.ala.net.in>) website was launched hosting 600+ old / previous question papers of HS Arts, Commerce and Science of AHSEC and BA and B.Sc. programme of Gauhati University. The website is accessed by thousands of students each day. In the coming days it targets to host the question papers of B.Com. programme of Gauhati University as well as all the undergraduate programmes of the different universities of Assam.

ix) Open Access Journals: A new website namely Open Access Journals (<http://oaj.ala.net.in>) was also launched with the links of 1009 high quality open access journals that mostly deal with the subject areas of undergraduate programmes of the different universities of Assam. Through this website, the college students, research scholars and faculty members can access tailored-made and subject specific Open Access Journals (OAJ) and retrieve their required article with much ease. In future, the platform is expected to launch a custom search engine for open access journals.

x) Vacancy in Assam: Vacancy in Assam (<http://vacancy.ala.net.in>) provides job notification to the unemployed youth of Assam on daily basis and also weekly in digest form. The website tries to cover almost all the job posts published in all newspapers of Assam and also in Employment News based on Assam. All job posts are categorized as Permanent Vacancies, Contractual Vacancies, Walk-in-Interviews and Deputation Vacancies. The website has the provision of linking Career Counseling or Guidance or Placement Cell of any college and sends the upcoming job notification to their students on behalf of the college.

xi) Organized National Seminar: Women Librarians' Association of Assam (WLAA)- a divisional member of ALA in association with LIS Links organized the National Seminar on Online Teaching Learning: Issues and Challenges during September 3-4, 2020 which was attended by 214 participants from India, Kuwait and Nigeria.

xii) Other Events: ALA organized webinar on Open Educational Resources on 29th July, 2020 wherein Dr. Mukesh Saikia, Librarian, Tezpur University and Professor Sanjay Kumar Singh, Head, DLISc., Gauhati University acted as a resource person. Further, an online Workshop on Scientometrics and Bibliometrics Analysis using Open Source Softwares was organized by Society for Advancement of Librarianship (SAL) in Association with Assam Library Association (ALA) on 6th June, 2020 wherein Mr. Shakil Ahmad, Lecturer and Liaison Librarian, Imam Abdulrahman Bin Faisal University Dammam, Saudi Arabia acted as the resource person.

xiii) Librarians' Day Celebration: To commemorate the 128th birth anniversary of Padmashree Dr. S. R. Ranganathan, Assam Library Association (ALA) celebrated the Librarians' Day on 12th August, 2020 in online mode in association with nine other associations and organizations i.e., Association of Special Libraries and Information Centres (IASLIC) Zone V, Assam College Librarians' Association (ACLA), Dept. of Library and Information Science, Gauhati University (DLIS, G.U.), Alumni Association of the DLIS, G.U., K.K. Handique Library, G.U., Central Library, Tezpur University, Women Librarians' Association of Assam (WLAA), Society for Advancement of Librarianship (SAL) and LIS Links (<http://www.lislinks.com>).

xiv) Publications: The conference volume of the National Seminar on Online Teaching Learning: Issues and Challenges entitled "Online Teaching-Learning: Issues and Challenges" was published online. It consists of 106 pages bearing ISBN No.: 978-93-5408-234-4.

xv) Maintaining Transparency: Almost all the transactions were done online and the half yearly bank statement along with audited reports of the association were put over the website for the members to view and experience the working style of the ALA.

xvi) Others: During the tenure of the past EC, the ALA got its own PAN card and online banking account and it has started conducting the election of the ALA in online mode with Prof. Dilip Kr. Medhi, Department of Hindi, Gauhati University as Returning Officer. It has made the comprehensive directory of the divisional members, institutional members and life members.





Thought of a Librarian

The entire library ecosystem is passing through an unprecedented time, a time of confusion and utter uncertainty prevailing all around due to new normal. Perhaps the challenge posed by the Corona pandemic to this profession is the biggest in the known history of our lives. As a librarian, seeing desolate library lobbies, barren stack-areas, carrel-desk without users, books want-off transactions, and other depressing scenarios make me feel absolutely painful. I am sure every librarian is passing with the same feelings in their hearts in this pandemic. How to regain and establish the enduring values of libraries has become an acute issue in this uncertain moment.

On the other hand, transitioning this pandemic uncertainty into an opportunity to revitalize the 'info-network' to reconnect with about 38.5 million users (Business Standard podcast) pursuing higher education in India is another standpoint of the librarians. Not in India alone, globally around 250 million (UNESCO) students in higher education have lost primary physical connectivity with one of the most enduring support systems of education, i.e. library. Invigorating and reconnecting them into a robust futuristic mechanism of knowledge capitol and securing the system from all potential pandemics would be one of the most challenging tasks for librarians worldwide.

'Virtualization' of the library activities and services during the Covid-19 pandemic has become one of the much-glamorized buzzwords. However, there was practical hitch due to weaknesses and incompleteness of digital infrastructure in many parts of the world like ours. There is no doubt that the COVID-19 pandemic has enormously helped us in understanding and utilizing state-of-the-art technology of the digital world very quickly, including self-service and touchless 'traffic-control' at the library. There are also many open educational resources and subscribed online resources to strengthen virtualized services. Therefore many professionals started believing that Covid-19 pandemic has a message to the mass that 'there is no need for patrons to visit the library to use the services physically any more'.

Nearly all academic libraries are attached to higher education institutions to support their curriculum for study and research. Therefore, as it is now revealed that virtual classes are not matched with classroom pedagogy in terms of quality teaching, likewise physical tour to a library for exploration of resources therein is a piece of mind and pleasure to a reader's soul. Be it a public, private or academic, a library is a community centre for a specific group of people; for that reason, without the 'community, the 'centre' does not exist. The purpose of a library is not only to disseminate books and documents; its stack, space and ambience offer freedom of mind to recreate knowledge and thus it is aptly called-a laboratory of mind.

LIS in Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) of Dibrugarh University

Dibrugarh University introduced Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) in Library and Information Science in the year 2020 for the BA / BSc. / BCom programmes (All Subjects of all Streams including both Honours and Non Honours) in CBCS.

As this skill enhancement course is meant for the Under Graduate programme of the affiliated Colleges under Dibrugarh University, the College Librarian with requisite qualification is entitled as Course Teacher of the said course. Simultaneously the Librarian as Course Teacher is also entitled to Evaluation of the examination related matters as per DU regulation. The total Credit of the course is 2 (included in 3rd semester or 5th semester for 2 credits and 4th semester or 6th semester for 2 credits).

The course was introduced with the following objectives

- To foster a basic understanding of the academic library system and services.
- To acquaint with the enormous resources available in various domains of Knowledge.
- To acquaint with the exponential growth of information & ensuring smoother access.
- To enhance the information search skill and to make students efficient enough to identify qualitative information resources for study and research.

The syllabus of the course was notified vide notification no. DU/DR-A/8-1/21/030 Dated 12.01.2021, primarily focusing on the Basics of Library and Information Science (Course-I) and Library in ICT Environment (Course-II). Total 958 undergraduate students have enrolled in this course and Sixteen College Librarians have been engaged for the said courses to date.
